This lecture celebrates the 175th anniversary of the Geological Survey of Canada (GSC), the very first scientific body established by the Government of United Canada on April 14, 1842.

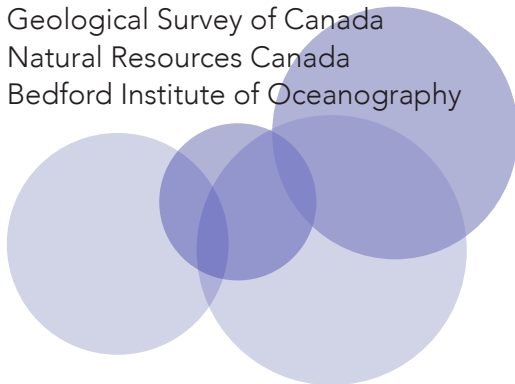
From the initial William Logan era including his early work done in Nova Scotia, through to today, the Survey helped grow a fledgling nation.
