Prizes

\$500

for the best paper written by an Undergraduate Student.

\$750

for the best paper written by a Postgraduate Student.

Awards Presentation:

Notification of awards will be made by email by the end of March 2021. Awards will be presented at 7:30 PM at the April 12, 2021 NSIS meeting.

POSSIBLE TOPICS

Papers should be directed at a non-specialist audience with interests in science, and should involve one of the following:

- 1 A substantive original essay reviewing some aspect of current science, including its relevance, significance and/or application, and your analysis/perspective.
- 2 Presentation of your original scientific research or research in which you have participated significantly. Include insights into the significance of the research and potential applications.
